BPS Crime Statistics (Q3 2009)

Executive Summary

- Crime has increased by less than **1%** compared to last year.
- Crimes Against The Person are still higher than we would like and are up by **21%** compared to last year. However serious assaults decreased from **37** to **29** offences (**↓28%**).
- Reporting of minor and non injury assaults is increasing.
- Crimes Against Property are down **4.3%** compared to last year, however we are concerned about elevated levels of residential burglaries.
- Crimes Against The Community decreased by **16%** over the previous quarter.
- Antisocial behaviour has declined by **18%** over the same period.

Executive Summary (2)

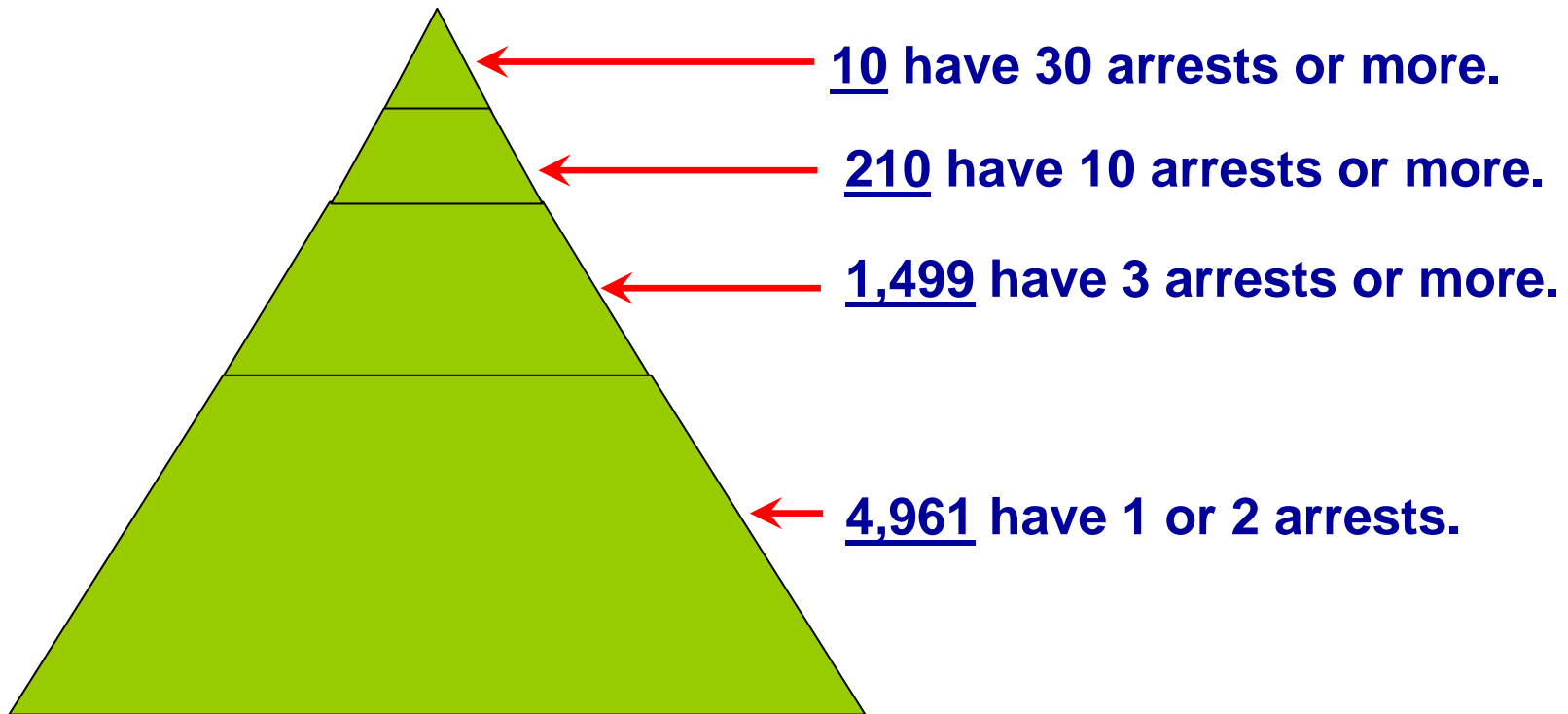
- Traffic Collisions. The long term trend is decreasing however we are still concerned about the number of fatal collisions (**11** fatal collisions in the first 3 quarters of 2009 compared to **13** in the same period in 2008.)
- Drug enforcement up by **38%** over the same level last year.
- Traffic enforcement up **44%** over the same level last year.
- During first 3 quarters of 2009 there have been **18** confirmed firearms incidents with **9** persons arrested for firearms offences this quarter. In 3 incidents persons were injured, with **1** resulting in death.
- Police activity and calls for service increased by **43%** over the same period last year.

Executive Summary (3)

- Arrests up **20%** over the last quarter and increased by **54%** over last year.
- More arrests by Q3 2009 (**3,247**) than in entire year of 2008 (**3,163**).
- Discounting warrants, the most arrests were for drugs and violence.
- Police stop and search activity increased by **20%** over the previous quarter.

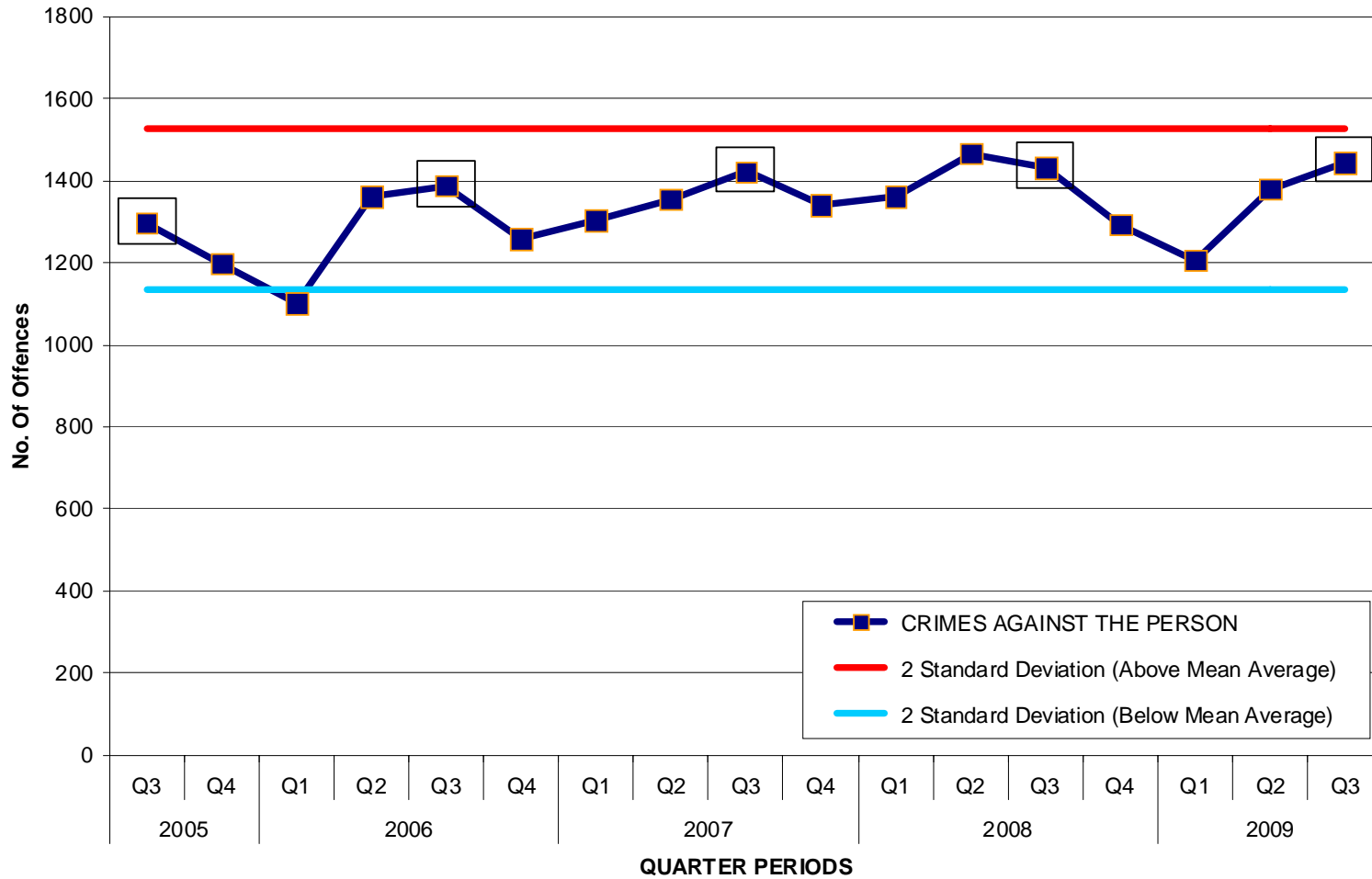
What is a PPO?

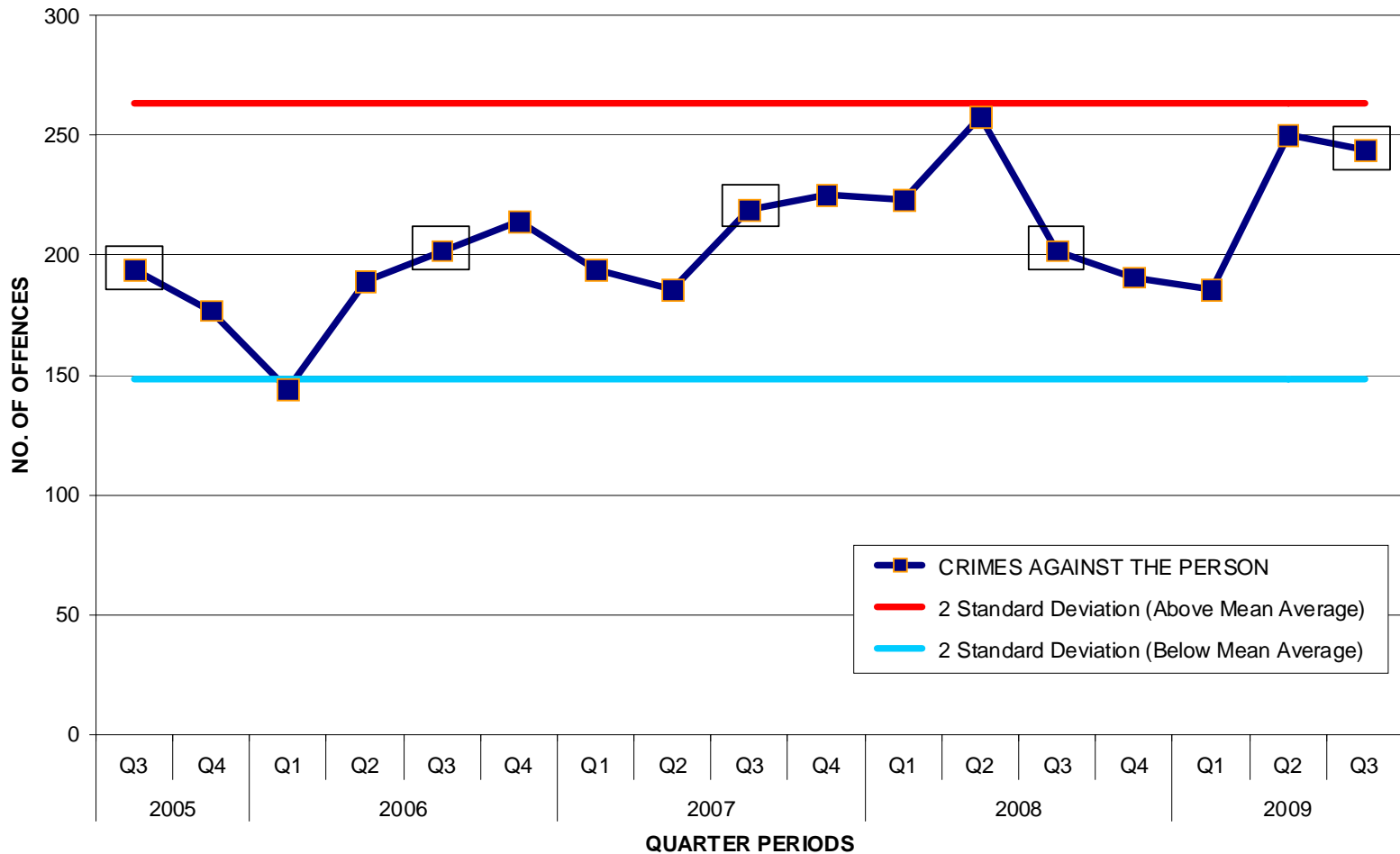

ALL CRIME (Q3 2005 - Q3 2009)

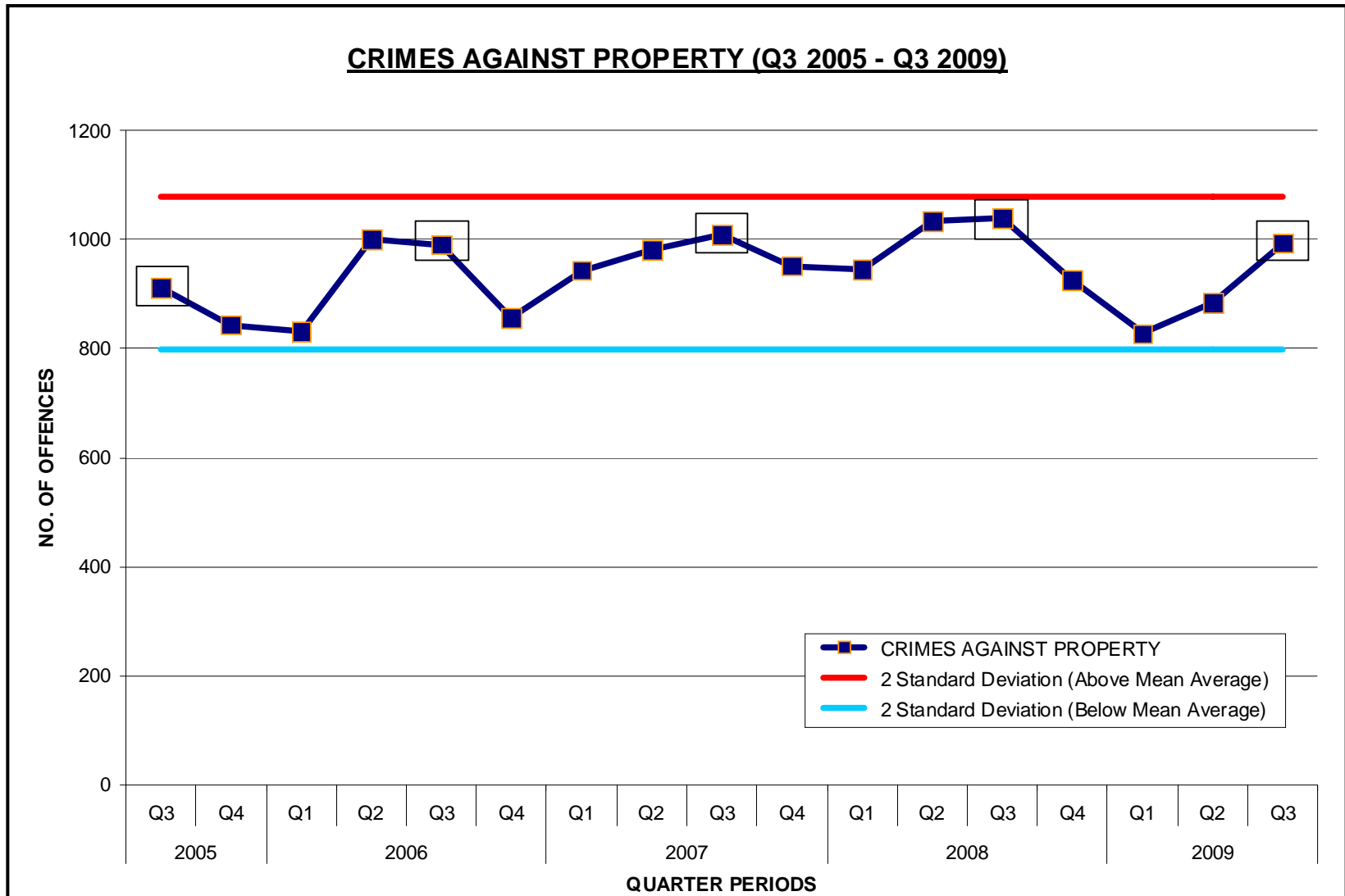

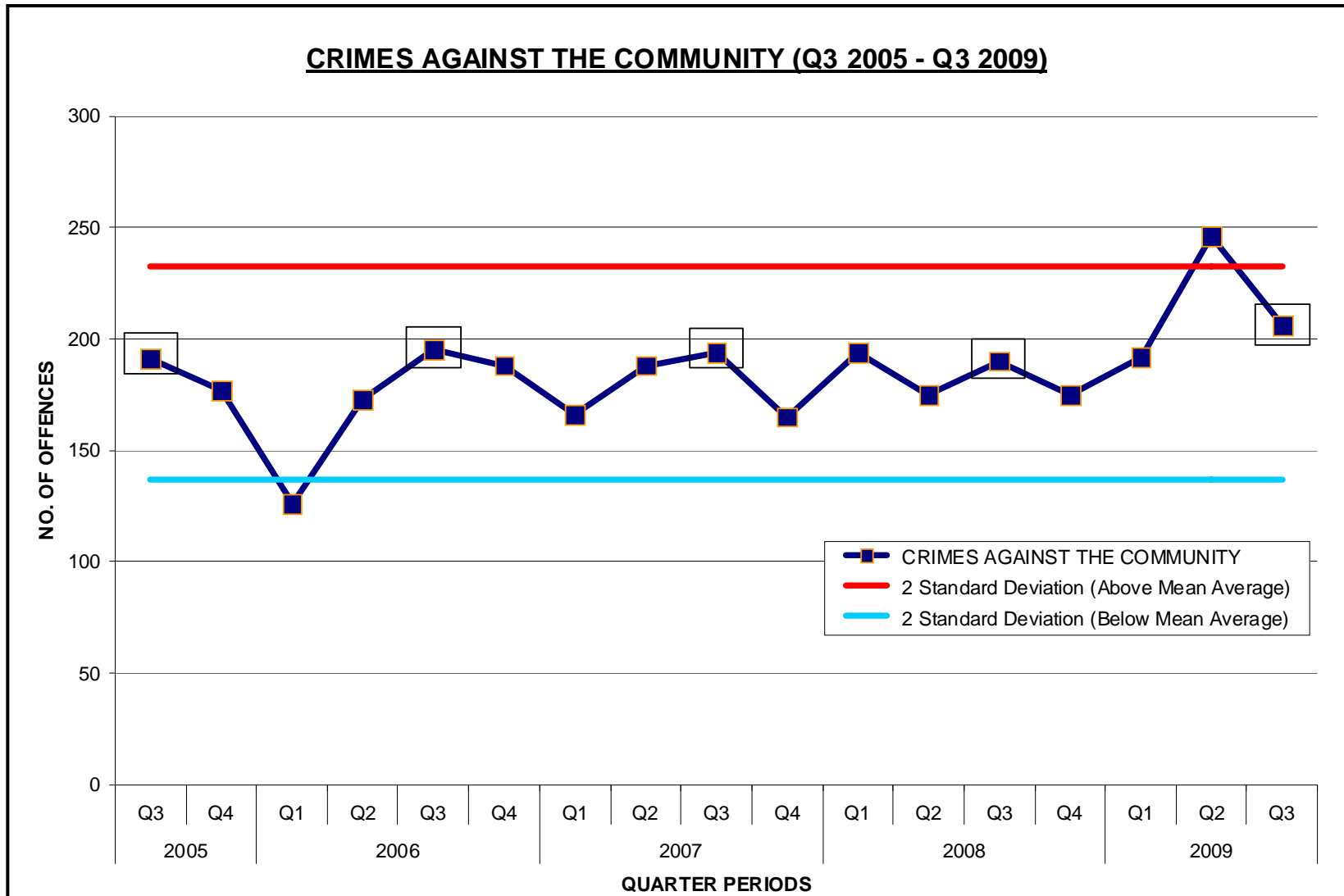
CRIMES AGAINST THE PERSON (Q3 2005 - Q3 2009)



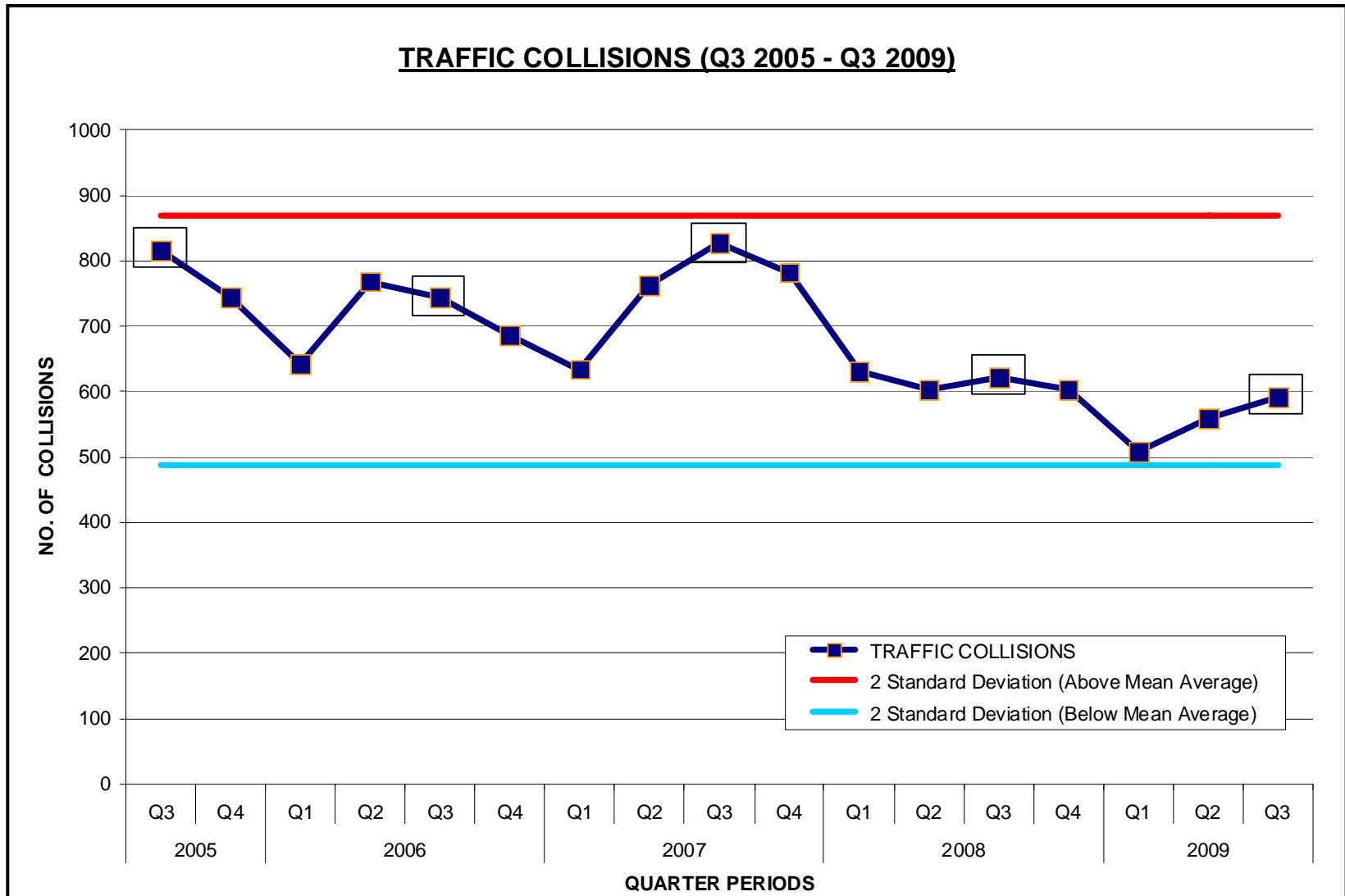
Crimes Against Property



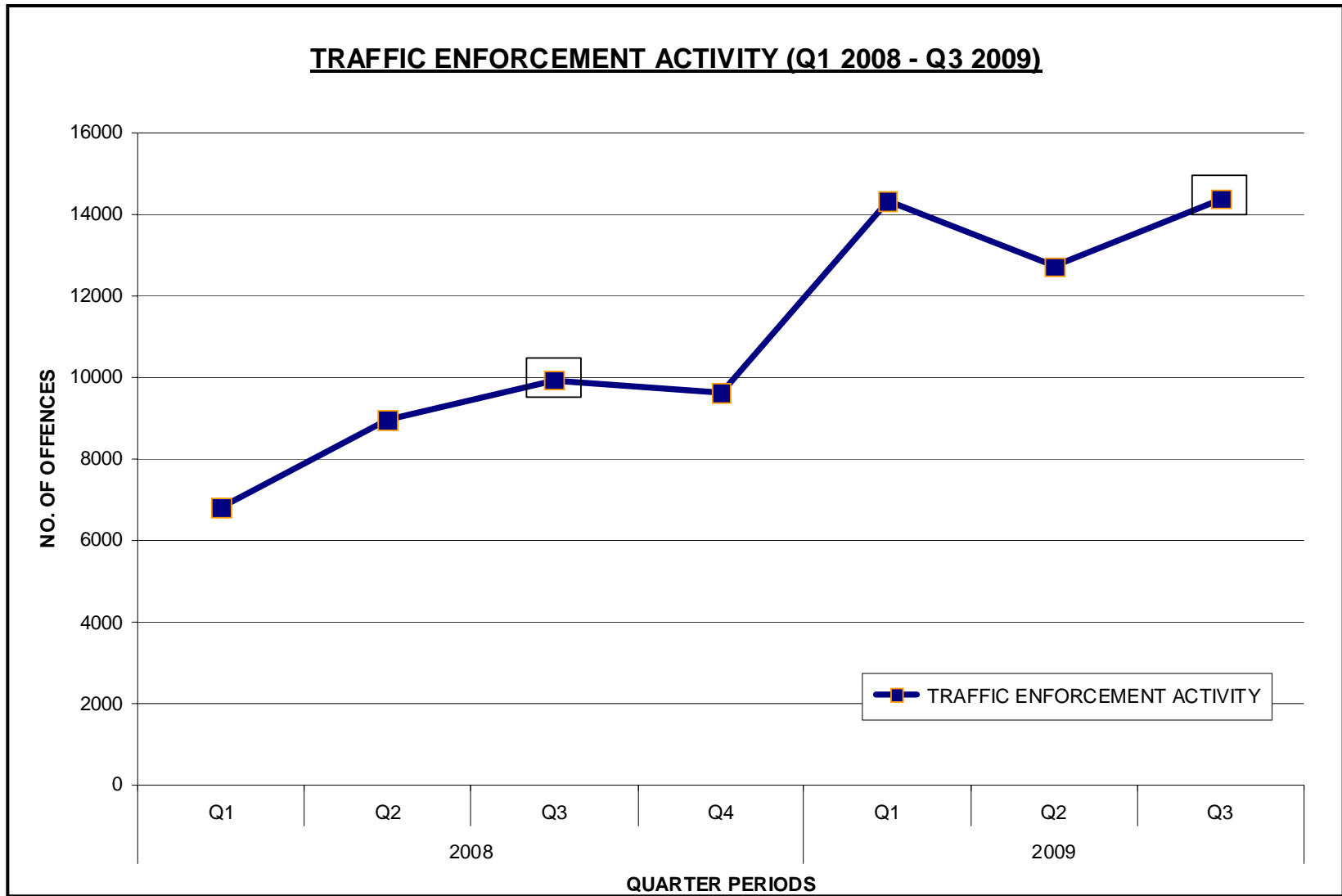

Traffic Collisions

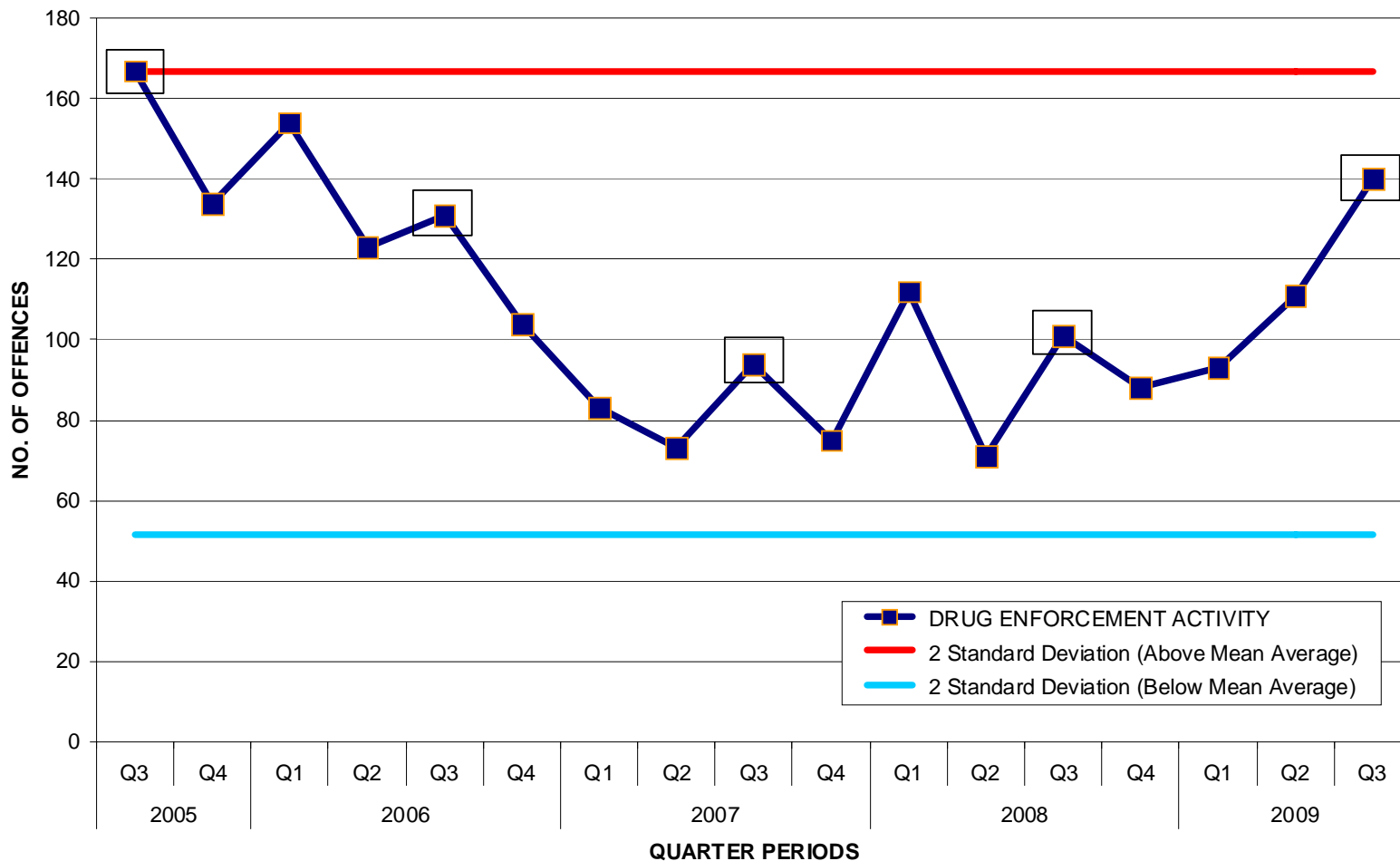


Traffic Enforcement Activity



Drug Enforcement Activity

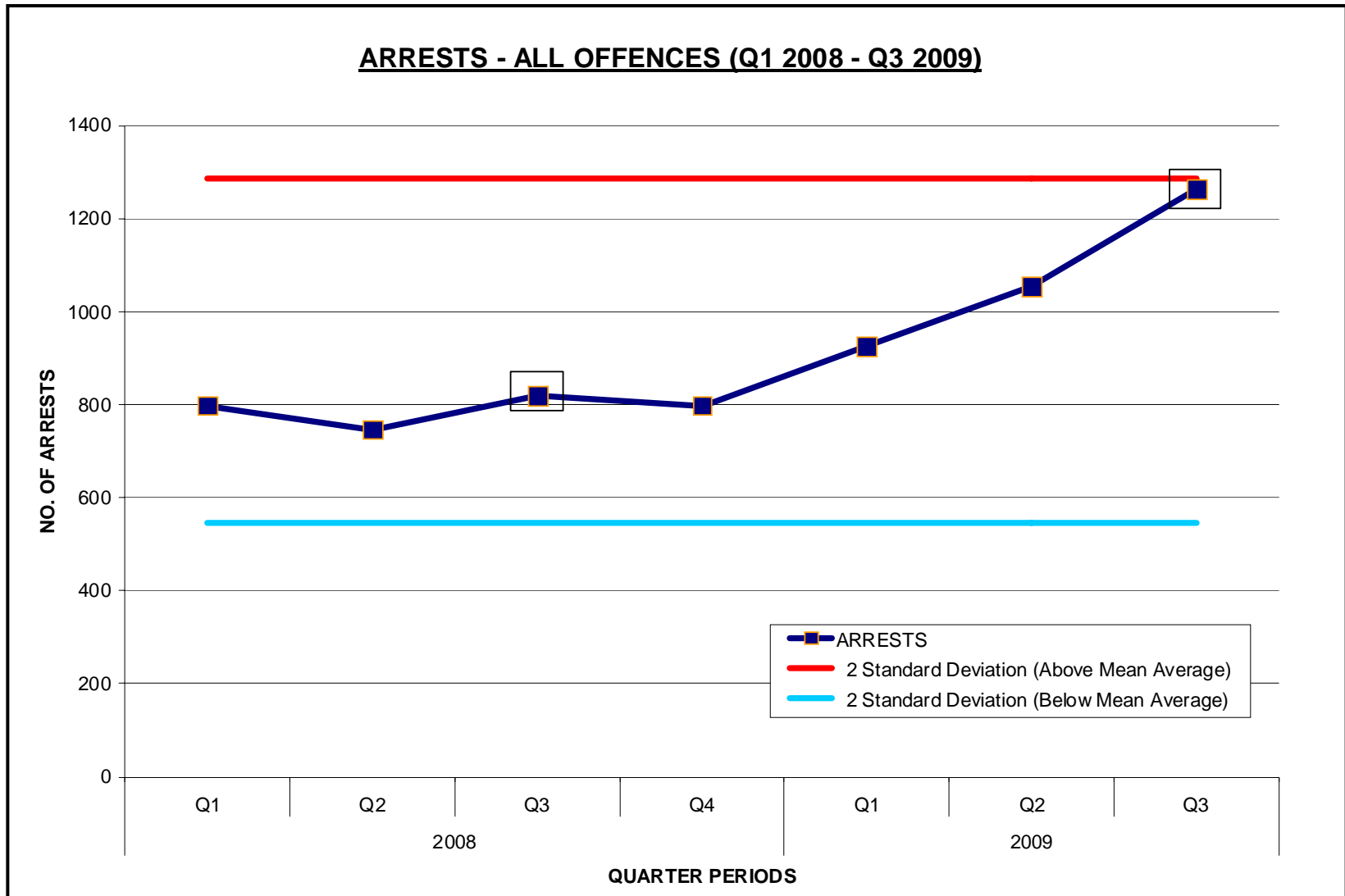

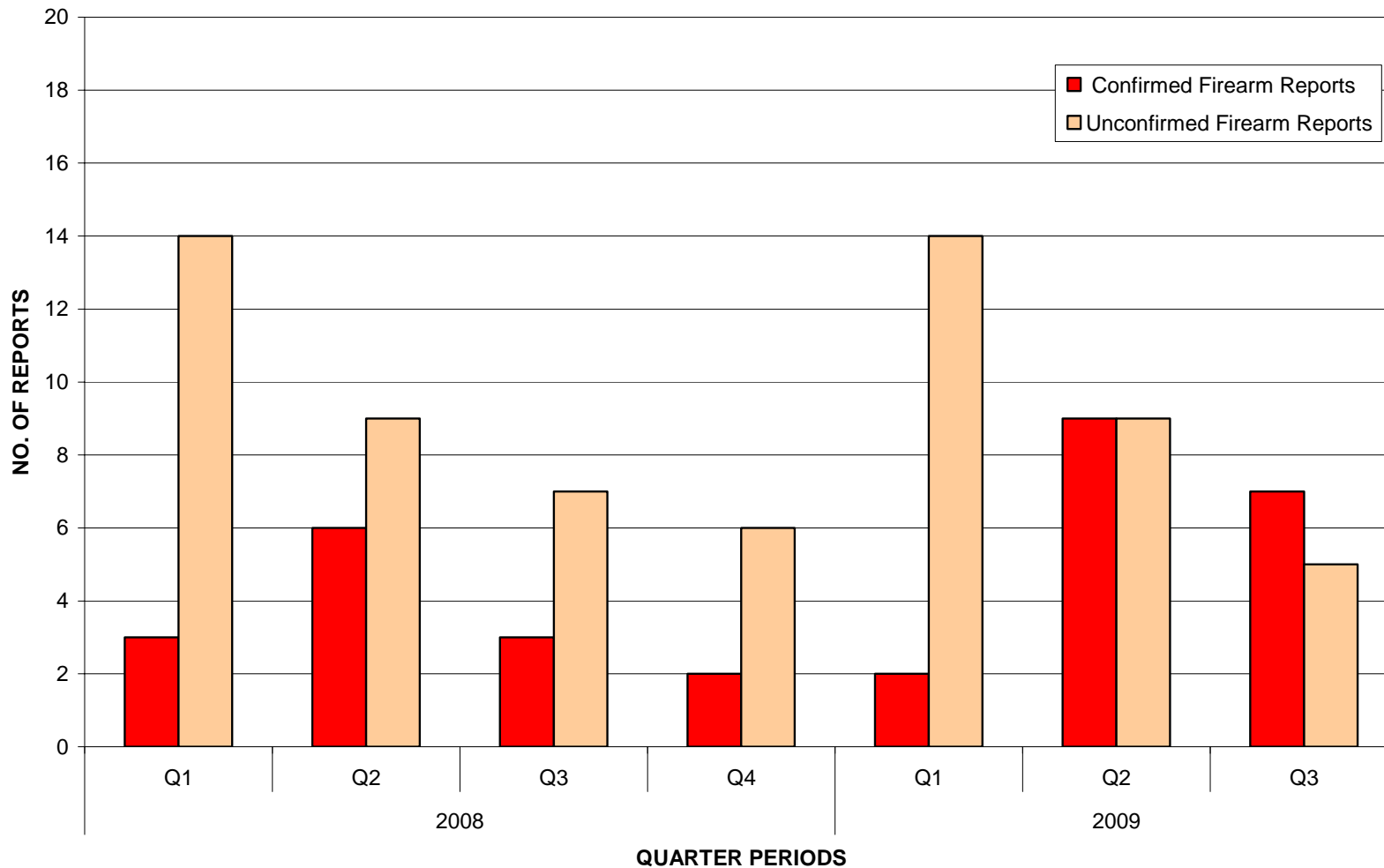

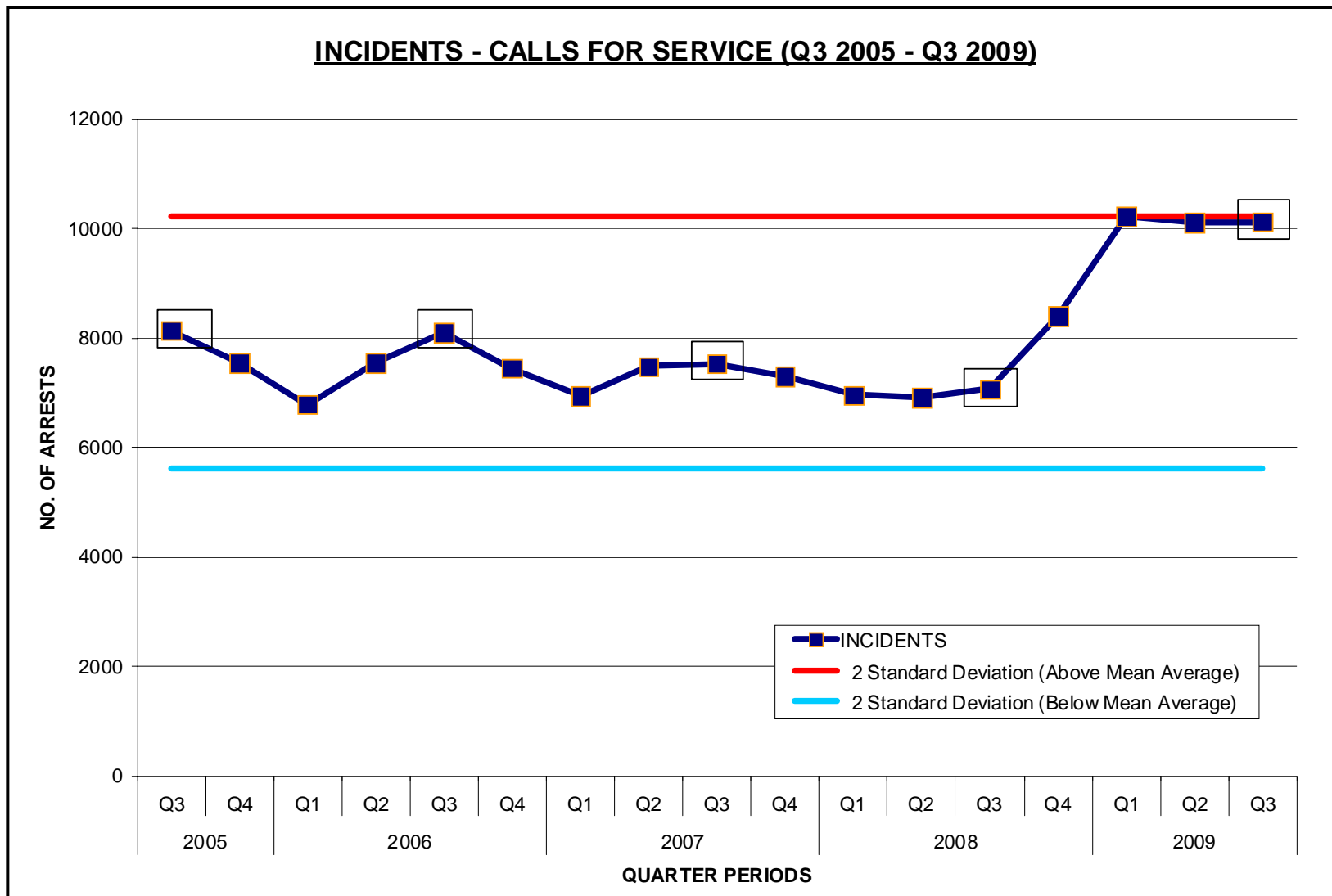
