Executive Summary

The total for **All Crime** in Q1 2010 was **1,185**.

In comparison to the previous quarter (Q4 2009), all crime in Q1 2010 **decreased** by **-119** offences or **-9%**.

In comparison to the same period last year (Q1 2009), all crime Q1 2010 has **decreased** by **-21** offences or by **-2%**.

Of the **20** crime categories, **13** have registered quarter on quarter decreases, **3** are the same and only **4** have increased.

Crimes Against The Person -35 (except Serious Assaults).

Crimes Against Property -84 (except Fraud and Deception).

Crimes Against Property no change (Firearms **+13**, Other Weapons **-13**).

Executive Summary (2)

Crimes Against The Person in Q1 2010 was **211**.

Crimes Against The Person offences in Q1 2010 **decreased** by **-35** offences or **-14%** compared to Q4 2009.

Crimes Against The Person offences in Q1 2010 **increased** by **+25** offences or by **+13%** compared to Q1 2009.

- **Murders decreased** from **3** → **2**.
- **Robbery decreased** from **30** → **14** (the lowest for 5 years).
- **Other Assaults decreased** from **163** → **146**.
- **Offences Against Children decreased** from **12** → **5**.
- **Serious Assaults increased** from **26** → **33**

Executive Summary (3)

Crimes Against Property in Q1 2010 was **720**.

Crimes Against Property offences in Q1 2010 **decreased** by **-84** offences or **-10%** compared to Q4 2009.

Crimes Against Property offences in Q1 2010 **decreased** by **-123** offences or by **-13%** compared to Q1 2009.

Burglary Residential **decreased** from **197** → **163**.

Burglary Non Residential **decreased** from **75** → **68**.

Burglary Tourist Accommodation **decreased** from **6** → **4**.

Motor Vehicle Theft **decreased** from **170** → **136**.

Theft Of Property **decreased** from **218** → **203**.

Fraud and Deception **increased** from **43** → **56**.

Executive Summary (4)

Crimes Against The Community in Q1 2010 was **254**.

Crimes Against The Community offences in Q1 2010 were the same as Q4 2009, the highest level for the last 10 years.

Crimes Against The Community offences in Q1 2010 **increased** by **+62** offences or by **+32%** compared to Q1 2009.

Other Weapon offences **decreased** from **29 → 16**.

Disorder offences **decreased** from **34 → 30**.

Firearm offences **increased** from **17 → 30**.

Anti-Social Behaviour offences **increased** from **173 → 177**.

Firearm and **Anti-Social Behaviour** offences are at a 10 year high.

Executive Summary (5)

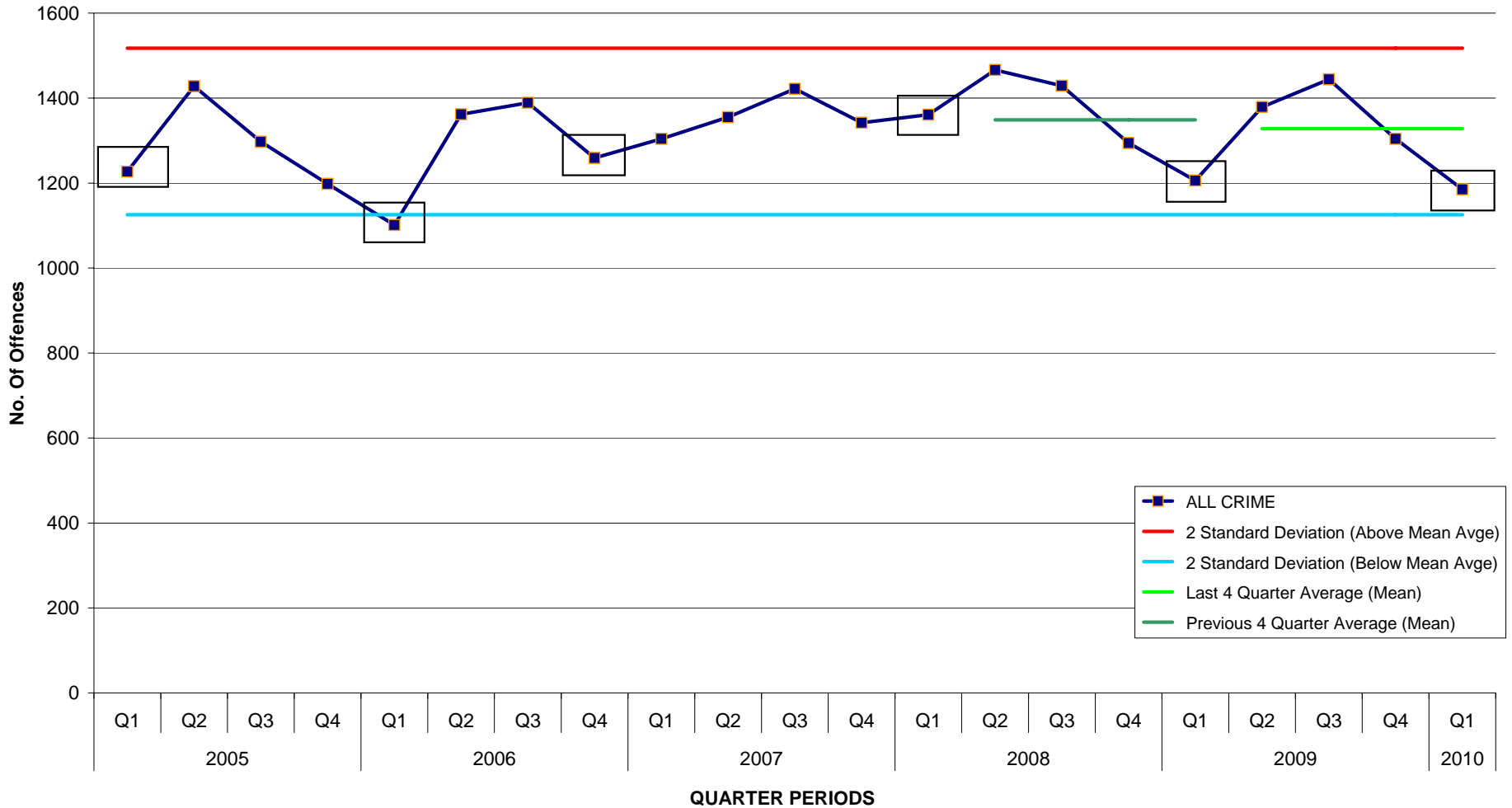
- **Traffic Collisions** are **-19%** at **508** in Q1 2010, the lowest level since Q3 2005. The long term trend continues to decrease and there are almost **100** less traffic collisions per quarter for the most recent 12 month period, when compared to the long term (5 year) average. However we are still concerned about the number of fatal collisions (**2** fatal collisions in Q1 2010).
- **Drug enforcement** up **18%** quarter on quarter and up **114%** year on year with **199** seizures in Q1 2009. An estimated total of **35Kg** of controlled drugs with an estimated street value of **\$1.7 million** has been seized in Q1 2010.
- **Traffic Enforcement** is down **18%** quarter on quarter and down **3%** year on year at **13,356**.
- **Police Activity and Calls For Service** is up **5%** quarter on quarter and down **8%** year on year at **9,391**.

Executive Summary (6)

- **Arrests** are down **1%** quarter on quarter yet up **40%** year to year at **1,300**. There were **11** arrests for murder and **15** arrests for firearm offences in Q1 2010.
- Police **Stop and Search** activity decreased by **24%** over the previous quarter however is at the second highest level since PACE was implemented in Q4 2008 at **1,028** in Q1 2010.

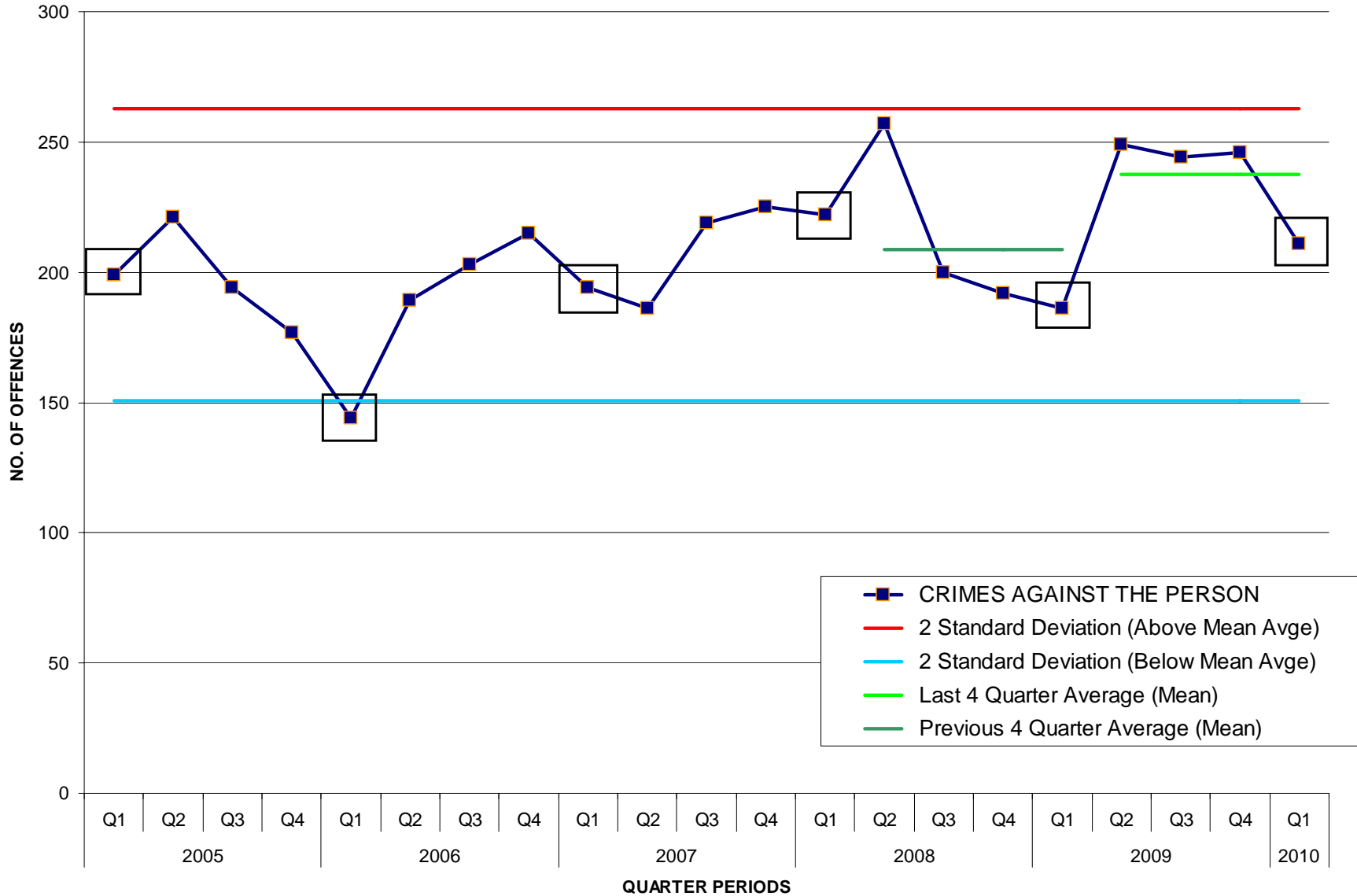

All Crime In Bermuda By Quarter (Q1 2005 - Q1 2010)



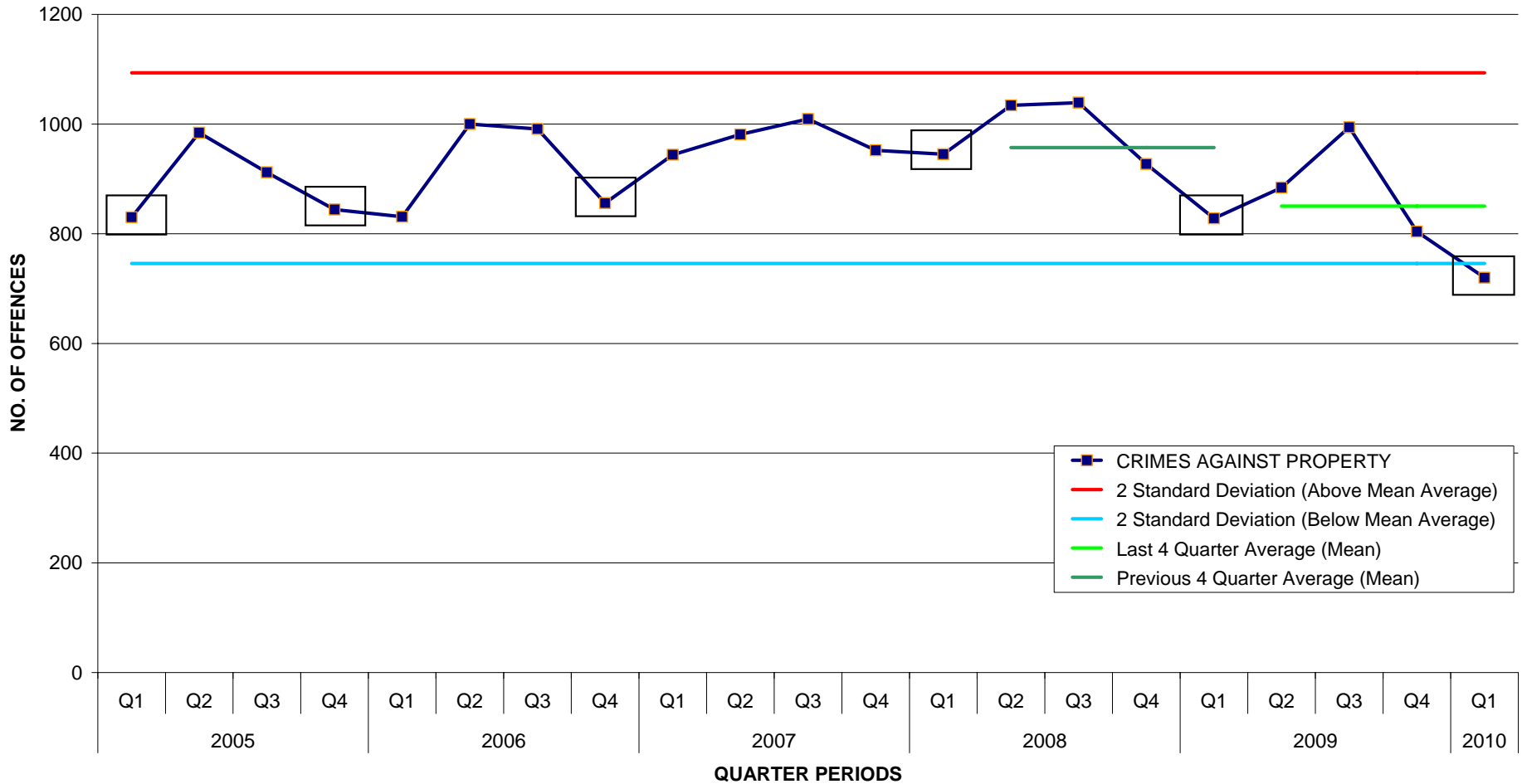

Crimes Against The Person (Q1 2005 - Q1 2010)



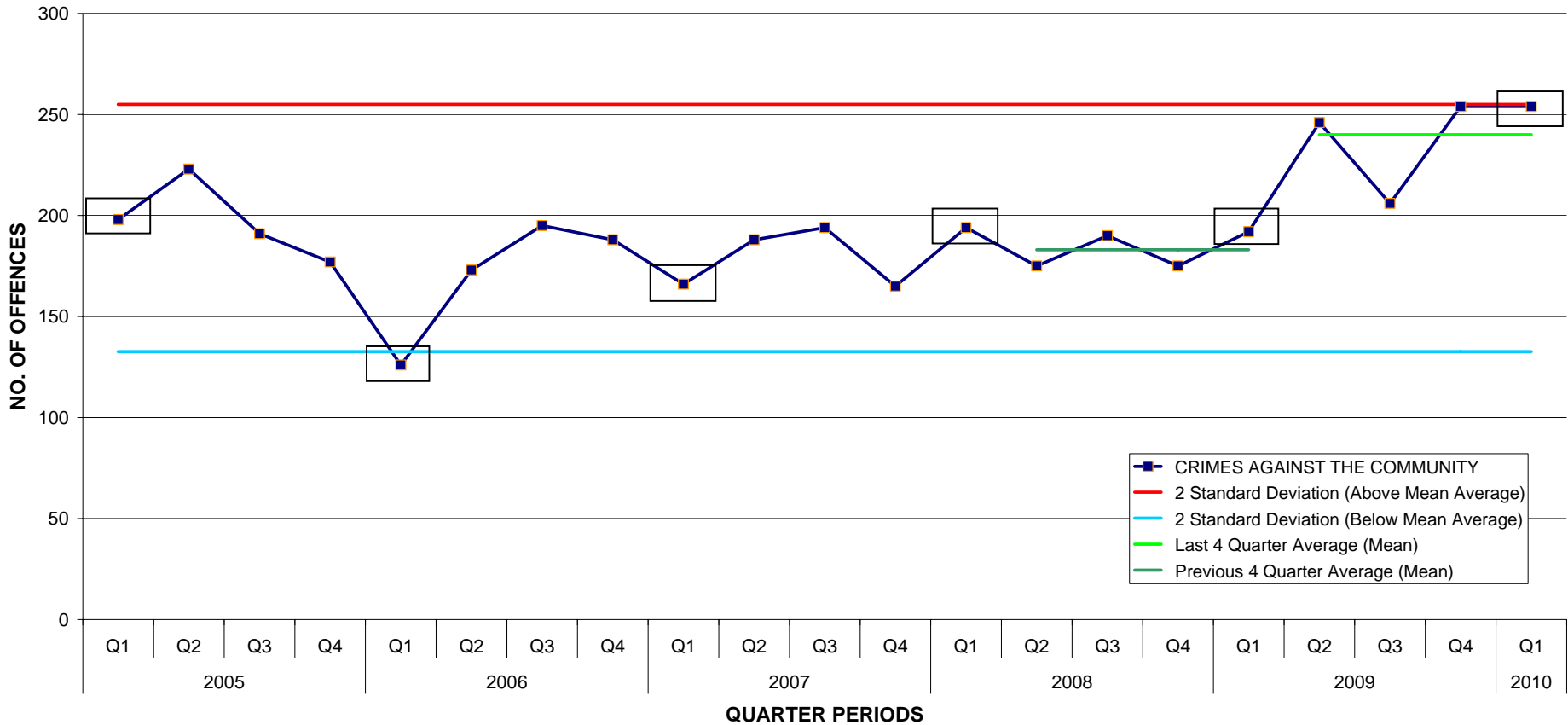

CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY (Q1 2005 - Q1 2010)



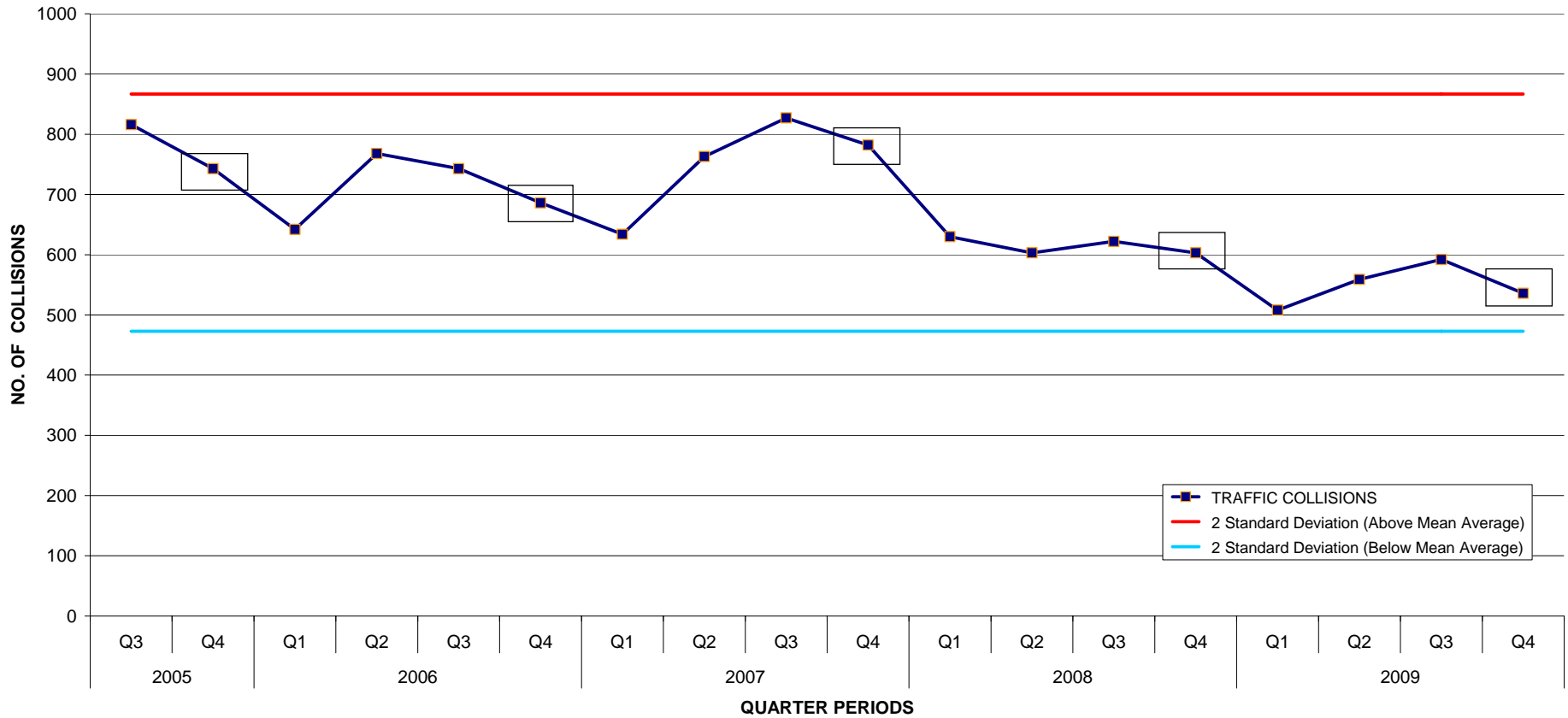

CRIMES AGAINST THE COMMUNITY (Q1 2005 - Q1 2010)



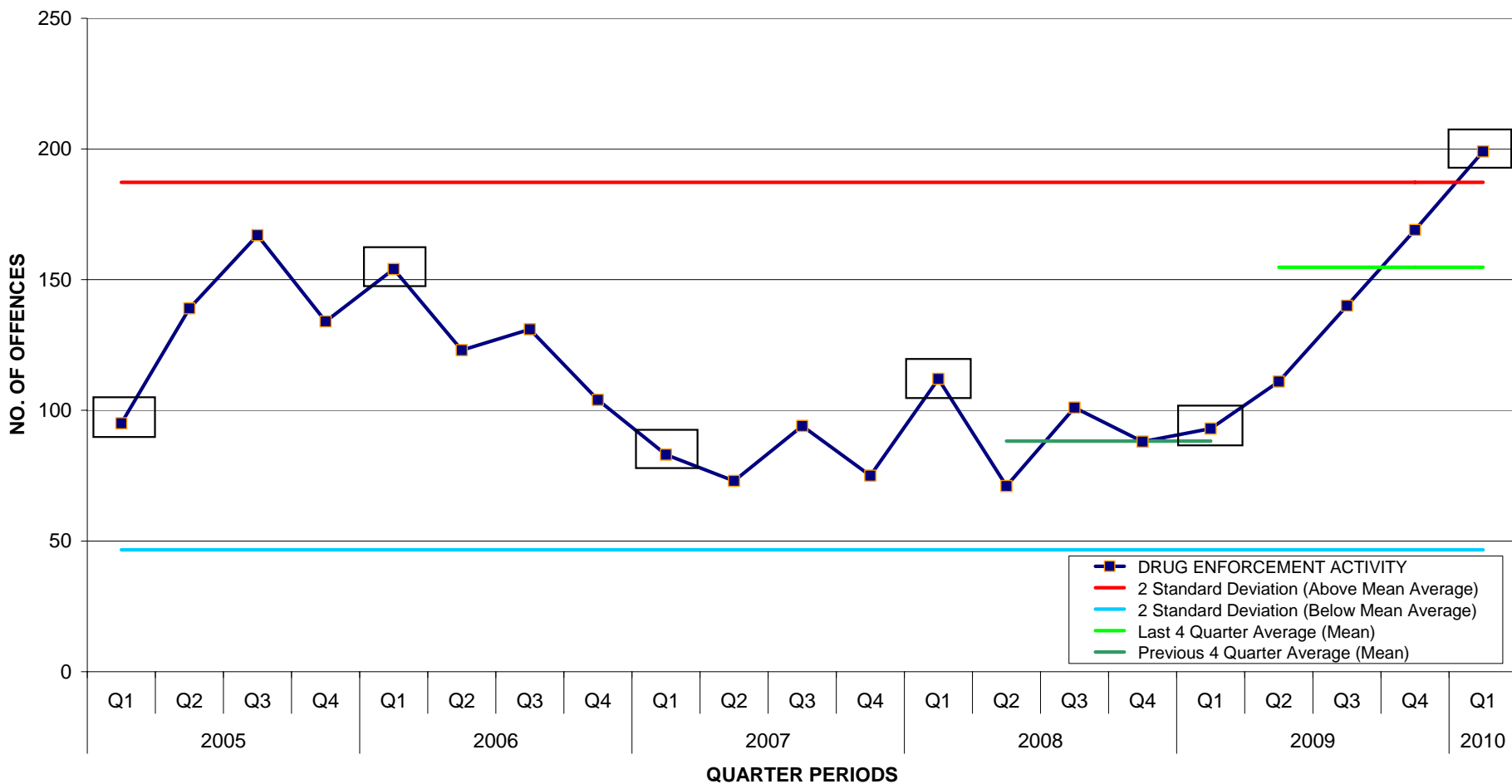

TRAFFIC COLLISIONS (Q3 2005 - Q4 2009)



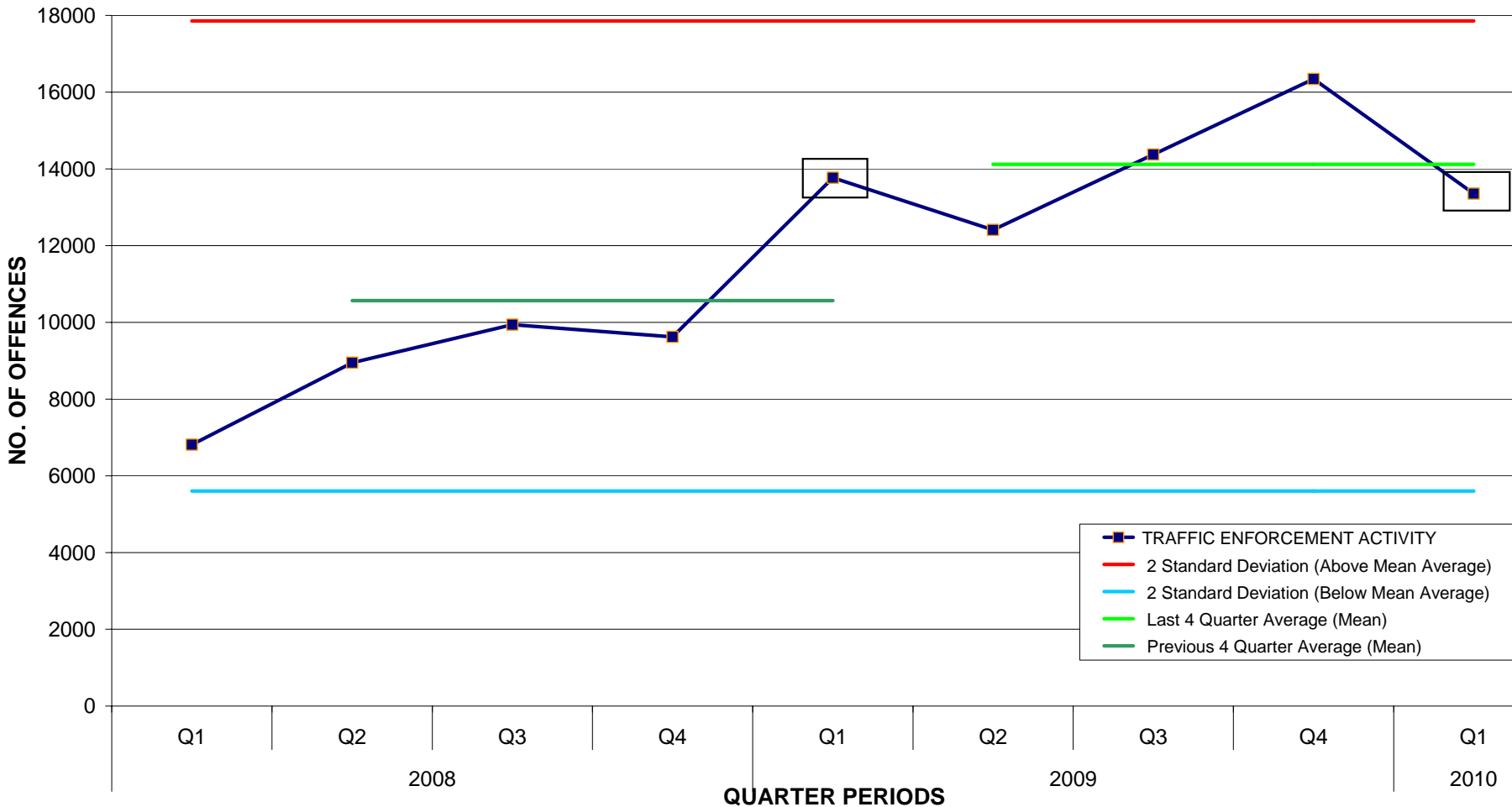

DRUG ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY (Q1 2005 - Q1 2010)



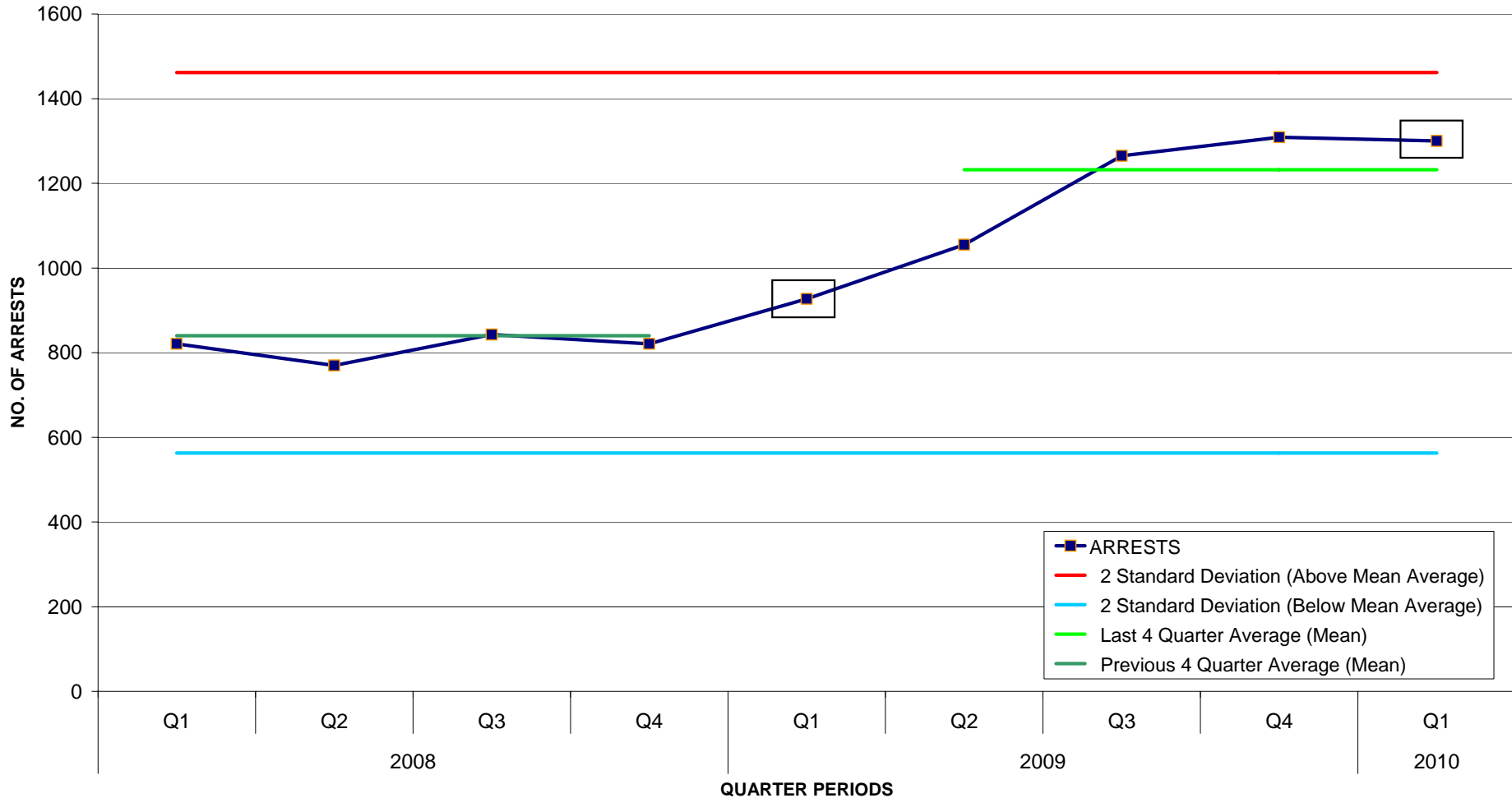

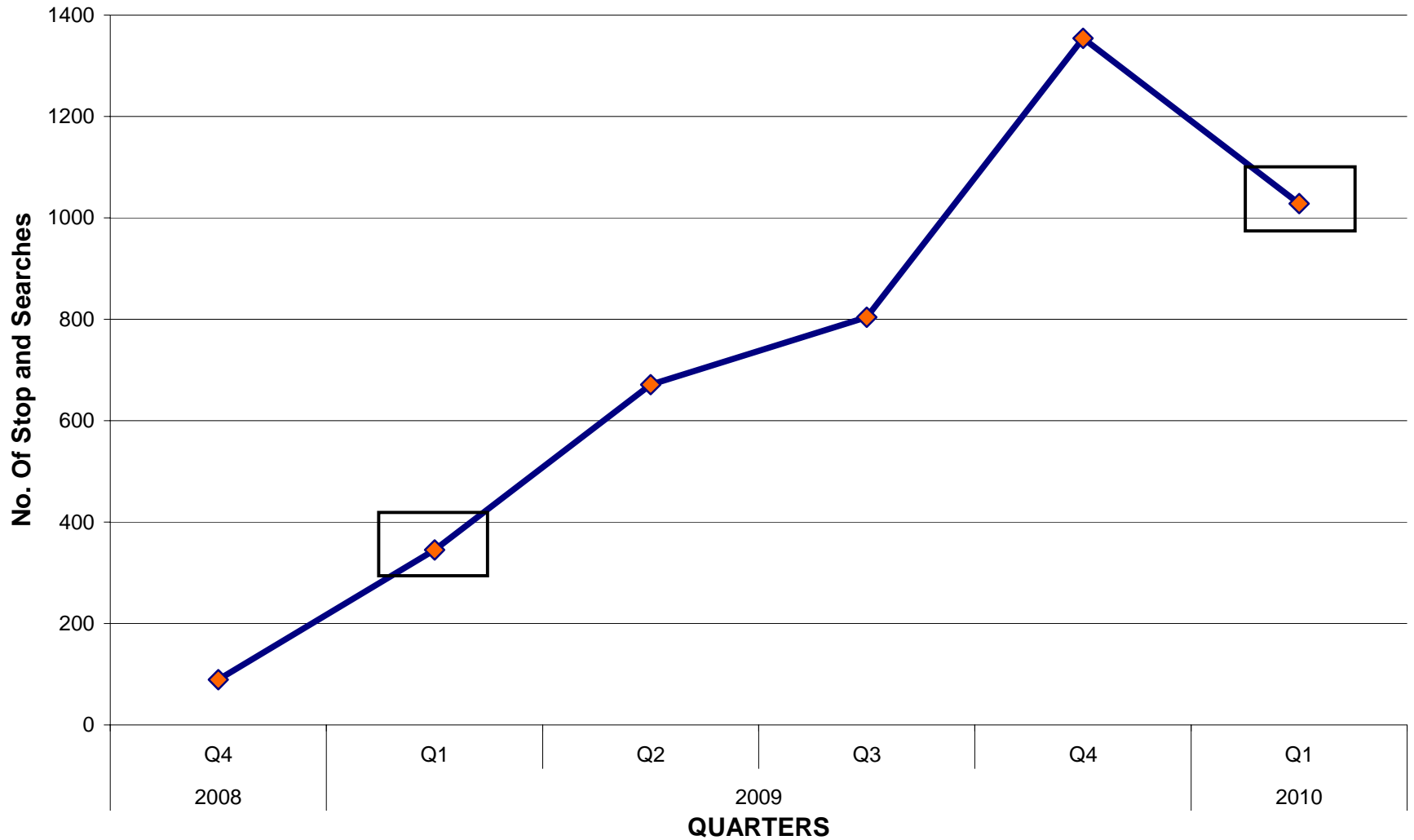

STOP AND SEARCHES (Q4 2008 - Q1 2010)



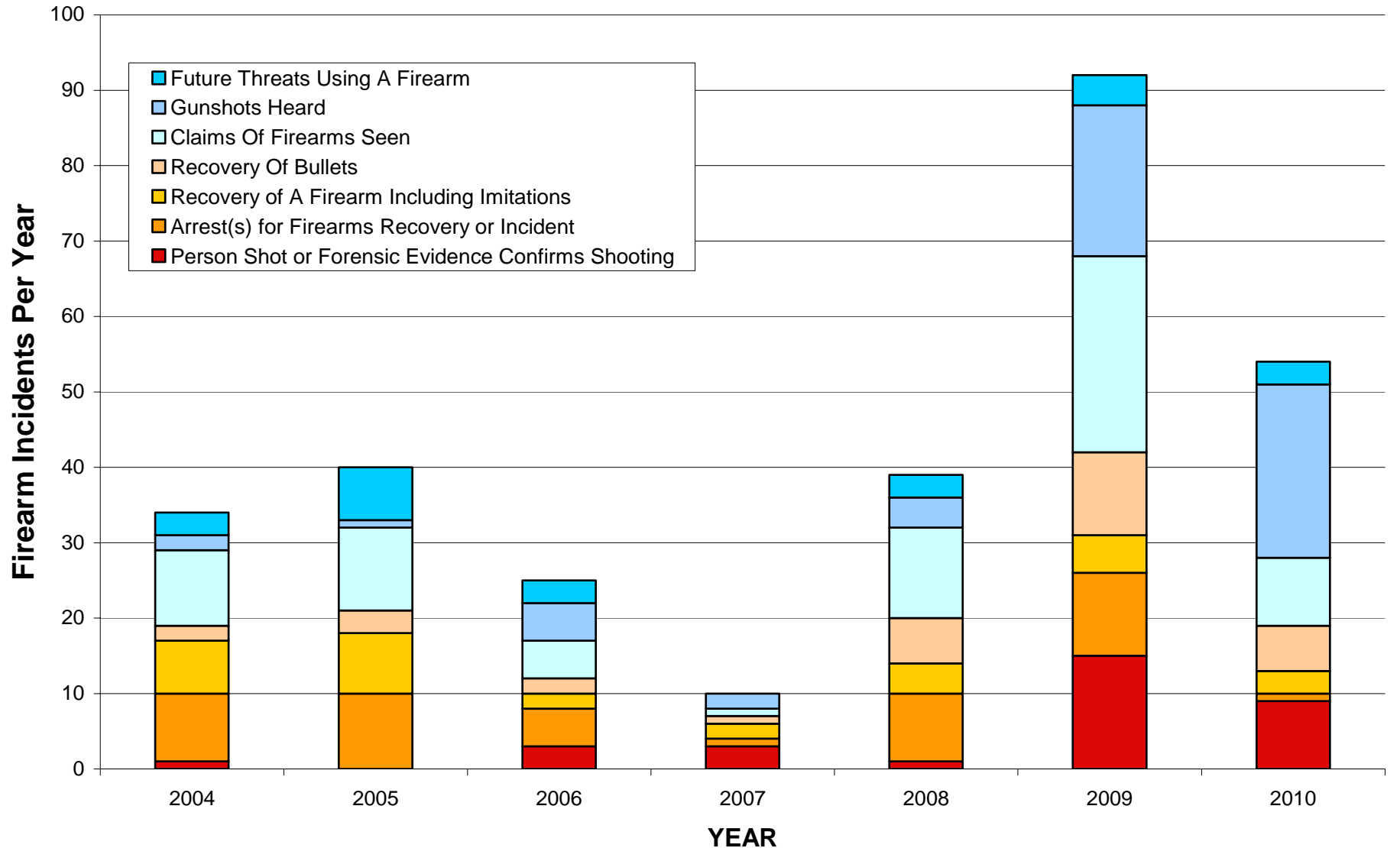

FIREARM INCIDENTS IN BERMUDA (2004 - Q1 2010)

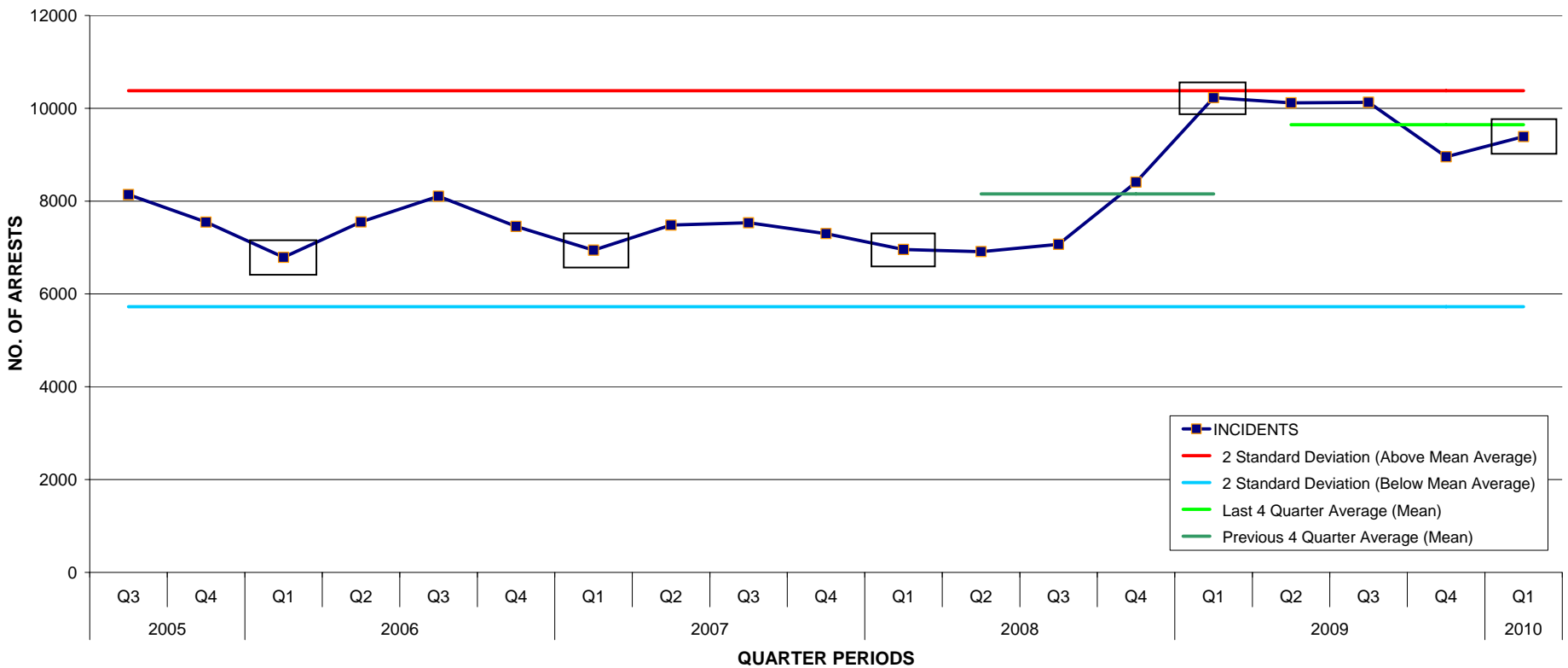
