PART 4 - EXPLOSIVE SUBSTANCE ACT 1974

Please note key requirements for application/issue of Explosive Magazine Licences, Special Licenses and Fireworks Permits under the Explosive Substance Act 1974

- Complete Application form on BPS website
- Commercial Occupancy Certificate Bermuda Department of Planning
- Fire Certificate Bermuda Fire & Rescue Service
- Approved security features of Magazine Government Security Officer
- Exceptional character Supported by at least one reference of significant standing

SPECIAL NOTES

Conditions of the Explosive Magazine Licence under Section 8 of the Explosives Substances Act 1974

- A magazine licence shall entitle the holder to store the maximum net quantity explosive substances specified in the licence in the magazine so specified
- o Annual application
- Approval in writing by COP shall specify the maximum net quantity explosive substances which may be stored in such magazine.
- o Government Security Officer approval for security arrangements of magazine
- Review and approval for the magazine SOP's by the Joint Services Explosives Ordnance Disposal team (JSEOD)
- Any explosives remaining after expiry of Special License, it is the responsibility of the license holder to destroy in accordance with magazine SOP's'.
- Failure to complete this will result in Government destroying the left over or expired explosives which will be paid for by the license holder
- Monthly return to BPS on explosives held
- Regular inspections will be made at the Explosives Magazine by direction of the COP
- Key holders need to be listed with contact details in the event of an alarm activation or other need for Police / BFRS to enter the Explosive Magazine

Conditions and protocols of the Special Licence under Section 9 of the Explosives Substances Act 1974

- This is required to import, possess, use or manufacture explosive substances (which will include transport)
- Annual application
- Applicant must be qualified both occupationally and operationally by an accredited body recognized by BPS and BFRS



- Commissioner of Police is satisfied that applicant is of exceptional character to justify the exercise by him of his powers under this section, may grant to any person a licence
- Firework display SOP's including a site plan to be approved by JSEOD and BFRS prior to display licence being approved; in accordance with the Pyrotechnics Guild International or other recognized body.
- Notification to Fire Dispatch and to Police ComOps (Control Room) with details of conveyance of explosives including timings, route, vehicle details
- Police JSEOD, and BFRS can attend and inspect fireworks displays setup, performance and take down as directed by the COP and Fire Chief

Fireworks Permit under Section 10 of the Explosives Substances Act 1974

- o Issued for one day this should include the rain date as the alternative which will be in the documents we provide regarding show and site plan
- o To a public officer, municipal corporation, manager of a hotel
- Protocols apply regarding transport and use
- Contact Fire Dispatch when transporting product to the event site to inform them of the route taken, the product carried and the amount being transported (296-7559).
- The company transporting and the license number of the vehicle.
- The vehicle transporting the product must be placarded and a manifest kept in the vehicle.
- Inform Fire Dispatch when the event is over and product is being transported back to the magazine
